No. Shram (A) 4-1/14-BOCW.—In exercise of powers conferred by section 62 of the Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1996, the Governor of Himachal Pradesh, after consultation with the Expert Committee, is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Himachal Pradesh Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2008 notified vide this Department Notification No. Shram (A) 4-6/2007-BOCW, dated 4th December, 2008 and published in Rajprta Himachal Pradesh on dated 8th December, 2008, namely :—

1. Short title.—These rules may be called the Himachal Pradesh Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) 2nd Amendment Rules, 2014.

2. Amendment of rule 266.—In rule 266 of the Himachal Pradesh Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2008, for sub-rule (3), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

“ (3) The application for registration shall be accompanied with a Certificate or wage slips from the employer or contractor or copy of Muster Roll or Attendance Register to

the effect that the applicant is a construction worker. If such certificate is not available, a certificate issued either by the registered Construction Workers Union or Executive Officer of the concerned Local Urban Bodies or Secretary of Gram Panchayat to the effect that applicant has worked for at least 90 days in the preceding twelve months may be considered. The certificate issued by agencies other than the employer shall contain complete details of the employer where the applicant has worked in the relevant period and such certificate shall be got verified by the authorised officer from the concerned employer's.
